Palm Desert, CA – A successful musical juggernaut for four decades, uniting audiences from Tasmania to Svalbard, The Ukulele Orchestra of Great Britain continues to reinvent itself with classy new tunes, brilliant performers and fresh perspectives on classic rock, pop and beyond—all played on the wrong instruments ... nothing but ukuleles in all the registers and sizes. The orchestra is returning to the McCallum Theatre at 7 p.m., Sunday, April 14.
